



Soraya Chemaly is an internationally published artist whose work is regularly featured in home decor catalogs, magazines, art web site sites and retail stores. Most recently she was chosen as the featured artist for the launch of Artaisance.com, Larson-Juhl's online art portfolio of customizable art. Her lush paintings of stylized and fanciful convey simplicity, beauty and an exuberant sense of movement.

Applying and mixing colors directly to the canvas results in paintings that are deep in color, texture and vibrancy. She enjoys creating large, simple images that focus the viewer's attention on unconventionally contrasted, but harmonious colors.

Ms. Chemaly, self-taught, began painting in 2003 and quickly developed a reputation for her large-scale, colourful work. She lived in the Bahamas for seventeen years prior to completing her education, at Georgetown University and Radcliffe College, in the United States and moved to Washington, DC in 1988.

The SORAYAJones brand, collaboration between Ms. Chemaly and her partner Thomas Jones, was launched in 2006, and includes a range of tabletop accessories designed to bring color and exuberance to the home. Her work is also licensed to an array of home décor brands, including Sisson Imports, Open Air Designs and Grand Image Publishers.
